ELIGIBILITY RULES

Due Date for Submissions:

Monday, April 15, 2024

2024 Theme:

“A Path to Diversity; A World of Inclusion”

Poems can address topics related to diversity, inclusion, respect for all, equity, breaking stereotypes, equal housing opportunity, or related subjects.

Grades: Open to students, grades 3-12, in Marin, Sonoma, and Solano counties. Only one poem per student.

Length and Style: Up to 50 lines in any style (double-spaced, 12-point font in a PDF)

Originality: Poems must be original.

Permissions: By submitting a poem, the student/parent/teacher/guardian grants Fair Housing Advocates of Northern California permission to publish the poem on the agency’s website or promotional materials in any format. (The poem will be accompanied by the student’s first name or initials.)

Why Submit a Poem?

Fair Housing Advocates of Northern California celebrates the beauty that each unique individual brings to our neighborhoods and our schools. We want to help prepare our children for a future where they will live and work with people of diverse backgrounds.
