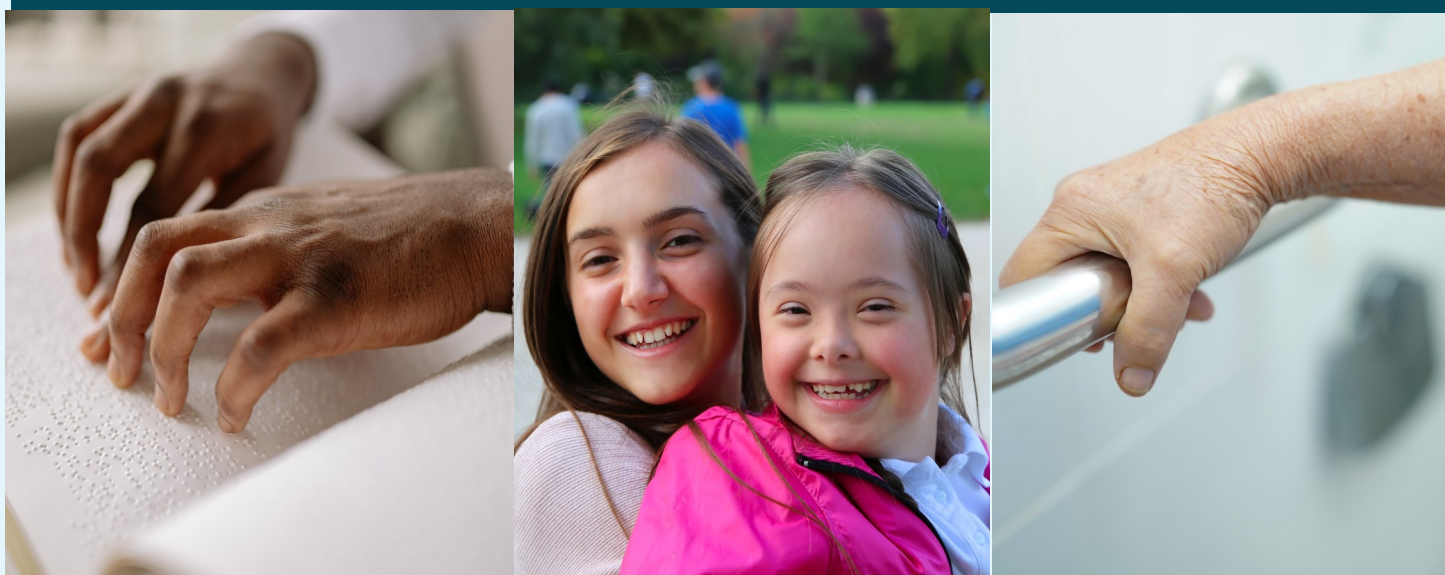
Successfully Housing People with Disabilities
