- Policing Violence, Municipal Fines, Fees, Debts
- Isolation from entry level jobs, fresh food, stores, health care

## Fair Housing Act 1968



#### A Law Designed to Be Weak

- HUD Could Investigate But Not Initiate
- 30 Days to Investigate Cases
- No Enforcement Power for HUD conference, conciliation, persuasion
- Plaintiffs had to bring cases quickly and prove discrimination on their own
- Damages Limited to \$1,000

#### Weakness Becomes Strength

- Because HUD has no enforcement power
- Only the Attorney General may sue, and only for a pattern or practice
- Housing Section of DOJ less than 24 lawyers
- "The main generating force" must be private lawsuits with citizens acting as: "private attorneys general in vindicating a policy that Congress considered to be a high priority."







- Use of Illegal Drugs


#### The Ideal and the Practical
